Announcing the **HIND/HORNETT Memorial Regatta** the (Twenty Third Annual Lake St. Clair Spring Doublehanded event) sponsored by the Doublehanded Sailing Association.

Spring is here and it is time to get your boats rigged and participate in this great doublehanded spring tradition!

- Date:** Saturday, May 15, 2010
- Course:** Approximately 17 miles (shortened course, approximately 11 miles) in SW corner of Lake St. Clair. Details will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.
- Start:** Off the Crescent Sail Yacht Club. First signal: 1055 hrs.
- Finish:** Crescent Sail Yacht Club, Grosse Pointe Farms, MI
- Picnic:** Casual get together at CYSC. Hot dogs, hamburgers and beverages will be supplied by the DSA. Bring your friends; everyone is welcome to attend.
- Awards:** Flags for first three finishers in each class awarded at the CSYC Clubhouse at conclusion of the race.
- Classes:** PHRF "A" and "B" and J.A.M. (DSA class rules apply) Important to complete rating Information on entry form. **Press passengers are allowed.** PHRF ratings will be used for all fleet splits. If you do not have a current PHRF rating, we will assign a rating.
- Entry Fee:** DSA or GLSS members: \$20 US dollars
Non DSA members: \$25 US dollars
Non-US Sailing members: Add \$3.00
(Due to 2009 race cancellation, entry fee waived for 2009 entrants)
- T-Shirts:** **New this year!** Regatta T-shirts will be available for pre-order (\$15). A portion of the proceeds from T-shirt sales will be donated to a charity in memory of Shelly Hind and Guy Hornett. T-shirt orders must be received by May 12, 2010.
- Entry Deadline:** To ensure proper fleet splits, entries must be received by **May 12, 2010**. Class splits will be posted at <http://www.sailwith2.org> May 13, 2010. Final class splits will be available from the Race Committee prior to the start.
- Rules:** The race will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing, as modified by DSA class rules and the sailing instructions. Preliminary sailing instructions will be posted, and will be posted on the DSA website at <http://www.sailwith2.org> on May 13, 2010.

Entrants are reminded to be in compliance with all necessary documentation required (i.e. passports, Nexus, etc.) for the United States and Canadian borders, for the skipper, crew, "press passengers," boat, etc., as applicable.
